

**Client Bill of Rights
Minnesota Statute 146A.11**

Subdivision 1.

Dawn Bennett, LMT, NCTMB, CCH, RSHom (NA) Dawn Bennett, LMT, NCTMB, CCH, RSHom (NA), Classical Homeopath, has been working actively with homeopathic clients since January of 2007. She is a member of the North American Society of Homeopaths, the Minnesota Homeopathic Association, and the National Center for Homeopathy. She is certified by the Council for Homeopathic Certification. Dawn has taken homeopathic continuing education from many instructors, including Jayesh Shah, Misha Noralnd, Rajan Sankaran, and the Joshis. She actively works with people of all ages with constitutional and acute homeopathic care.

Dawn has been a Nationally Certified massage therapist since graduating from the Utah College of Massage Therapy in December of 1997. She does a variety of massage and bodywork including deep tissue, myofascial release, and trigger point therapy. Although her focus traditionally was in deeper work, Dawn realizes the need and the benefit of lighter touch therapy, which led her to take visceral manipulation and CranioSacral therapy through the Upledger Institute. She completed the first two levels of Healing Touch training and the first level of Reiki. She also became a Repetitive Behavior Cellular Regression Practitioner in 2013.

In addition, Dawn worked for over ten years as an instructor teaching massage and complementary healing courses at Minnesota State College, Southeast Technical in Red Wing. These included courses in flower essence therapy, homeopathy, massage, business, and acupressure. Dawn completed her bachelor's degree in Business and Complementary Medicine from Metro State University in Minneapolis in 2009. Furthermore, she graduated from the Northwestern Academy of Classical Homeopathy in 2009, and is currently a student clinic supervisor there.

Dawn utilizes her knowledge of bodywork, homeopathy, and flower essences to help heal people of all ages who suffer from a variety of issues: from the flu and ear infections to anxiety, depression, and ADD. Finally, she travels throughout Southeast Minnesota and Western Wisconsin, speaking about complementary medicine and empowering people with options for their own health and healing.

If a client desires a diagnosis from a licensed physician, chiropractor, or acupuncture practitioner, or services from a physician, chiropractor, nurse, osteopath, physical therapist, dietitian, nutritionist, acupuncture practitioner, athletic trainer, or any other type of health care provider, the client may seek such services at any time.

Please note that appointments cancelled within 24 hours incur a 10% charge. If you do not show up for your appointment, you will be billed 50% of the cost of the appointment.

Personal packages, family packages and group rates are available. Fees are payable at the time of service. We do not accept Medicare, Medical Assistance, or General Assistance Medical Care. However, services and remedies can often be paid for with a Health Savings Account.

VII. Clients do have a right to reasonable notice of changes in service or charges, and we will provide prior notice of any changes.

VIII. Please see the article “Homeopathy; What you Need to Know” provided to you in your packet. Clients will receive courteous treatment, and will be free from verbal, physical, or sexual abuse by the practitioner.

IX-XVII. Your records and other information about you are confidential. This information will not be released, unless you authorize a release in writing, or unless the release is required by law. Clients have a right to all information kept by Body Kneads in accordance with section 144.335. The client has a right to choose freely from any type of practitioner in the area, and is free to change practitioners after services have begun. XIV-XV. You have the right to refuse services or treatment, unless otherwise provided by law. Clients may assert their rights without retaliation. Clients may refuse services or treatment at any time.
